



## Angel Manuel Diaz Sr.

November 24, 1921 - March 29, 2014

Angel M. Diaz, Sr. fell asleep in the Lord at the age of 92, on March 29, 2014. He was born on November 24, 1921 in Caguas, Puerto Rico. He retired to Yuba County, where he was a resident for 30 years. Prior to that he lived in New York City, where he met his wife and raised his family. He was a beloved father, grandfather, great grandfather, brother, and friend to many, many people from New York to California.

Angel was a member of St. Joseph's Church in Marysville, and a member of the Knights of Columbus. He was a retired Doctor of Chiropractic and a retired Pharmacist.
