David Brent Young, age 61, an eight year resident of Canon City, Colorado, passed away on April 7, 2015 at a Colorado Springs hospital after a courageous battle with liver cancer. He had retired after faithfully serving his country for over 20 years with the U.S. Army and attaining the rank of CW4. He then worked for the Fremont County Sheriff's Office as a Deputy Sheriff.
