Our loving wife, mother, grandmother, sibling, and friend, Denise Berg, passed away on April 17, 2026, at 76. She was at home surrounded by family.

Denise was born on October 22, 1949, in Stockton, CA, the daughter of the late Lew Wallace Bergstrom and Arlene Beth Johnson.

Her family moved to the Yuba Sutter area in 1954, when her father became manager of the State and Sutter theaters for Unites Artist Theater Company.

Denise grew up with the State Theater being her playground and watching movies and enjoying free popcorn and soda.

She was working as an usher at the theater when she was introduced to the love of her life by her best friend and coworker, the late Patsy (Milligan) Adams, and David's cousin, Parke Everett.

Patsy and Parke were dating at the time. Their first date was David's high school graduation party at the Berg Ranch,

After high school, she obtained a clerk position at the WT Grant store at Yuba

Plaza (now the mall). She was rapidly promoted to an office position due to her excellent working skills.

A friend of hers told her about an opening for a clerk in the pharmacy at Kaiser Hospital in San Francisco, CA, which paid over twice what she was making at Grants.

She applied and obtained the position and moved to San Francisco. Part of her motivation was to be closer to David, who was attending University of Santa Clara in Santa Clara, CA. About a year later she transferred to the Kaiser pharmacy in Santa Clara.

Denise and David were married in 1970 at the Berg Ranch in Sutter County and continued living in the San Jose, CA, area for the next three and a half years.

In 1974, they moved back to Sutter County and have been residents there since.

She worked as a teller for Feather River State Bank/Umpqua for 18 years and her supervisor considered her one of her best employees. She left there and worked for her husband at his CPA practice until last year.
