Our most recent conversations have been regarding his diagnoses and treatments as I had gone through the very same situation with being diagnosed with colon cancer and experienced the issues he was facing including the blood clots. He came to the Union Hall a month or so ago or maybe a little longer and wanted to talk.

It was the first time I had ever seen Dog so worried and unsure of things. We talked about the surgery and the chemo and what to expect. He looked at me through his teary eyes and very humbly said "Danny I'm scared". I said Dog you have no reason to be scared, your tough and if I can make it you can too..I expressed to Dog how I got my strength and my comfort by laying it at the feet of Jesus, and how the Bible tells us that Jesus will take these burdens on himself and free us from the worry of it. He assured me he had, had conversations with God and he was good, which gave me comfort knowing. We finished our talk with him making me promise I would do everything in my power to help Micheal get in to the apprenticeship program, and I assured him I would and will.

We will never understand why God needed Dog so soon. But I have a feeling Dog is waiting for the time when we meet him again in Heaven, and he will fill us in why he had to leave so soon. Just remember this, This life is only temporary, their is a much greater story to be told. RIP DOG.....
