William Pavloff, aka Russian Bill, passed away peacefully July 10, 2015, in his home surrounded by his loving family, at the age of 82. Bill was born Dec. 23, 1932, in Los Angeles, CA

Bill is survived by his loving wife, Olivia, along with children Cindy Treadway and Billie Pavloff. Along with granddaughters Stevie Lynn Cash and Jennifer Pavloff, grandsons Brandon and Christopher Pavloff, and three great grandchildren. Also survived by brother Martin Pavloff and sister Tanya LaDuca.

He was a veteran of the US Air Force, serving in the Korean War. He retired from the manufacturing industry, where his career led him to being the founder, owner/operator of his business which designed and built specialized springs, for civilian, military, and the aerospace industries.
